

## ARTICLE VII - REGULAR AND SPECIAL MEETINGS

### 1. Meetings:

- a. Regular Meetings of the Third Legislative District Democrats, including the Reorganization Meeting, shall be held at least four (4) times per year. The Secretary shall issue a Call for each Regular Meeting of the Third Legislative District Democrats to all voting members at least fifteen (15) days prior to the meeting.
- b. Special Meetings may be held at the discretion of the Chair, or upon written request of twenty (20) Third Legislative District Precinct Committee Officers. The Chair shall call the Special Meeting within thirty (30) days after receipt of a request. If the Chair fails to issue a Call for a Special Meeting as requested, then any five (5) Third Legislative District Precinct Committee Officers may issue the Call by sending a notice to all voting members at least fifteen (15) days prior to the Special Meeting.
- c. The organization may conduct its meetings wholly by electronic or other remote access means (such as Zoom technology); provided that the organization shall use its best efforts to implement any such virtual meetings with full regard for the need to maintain reasonable access for all members, including those with disabilities and those who lack access

to sophisticated technology tools. The organization may adopt Standing Rules regarding procedures to follow when holding virtual meetings.

- d. Call to meeting notices may be sent voting members electronically and shall be posted on the website and/or social media pages.
